Doctrinal Statement

Chapter 1, Section 1 of the FCS By-Laws

- I. We believe in the Scripture of the Old and New Testaments as verbally inspired by God, inerrant in their original writings, and they are the supreme and final authority in faith and life.
- II. We believe in the Trinity. One Triune God, eternally existing in three separate but equal Persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- III. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary. He is one Person with two complete natures--true God and true man.
- IV. We believe that man was created in the image of God, that man sinned, and thereby incurred not only physical death but also spiritual death, which is separation from God; All human beings are born with a sin nature and also become sinners in thought, word, and deed.
- V. We believe that the Lord Jesus died for our sins, according to the Scriptures, as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice—the Innocent One in the place of us guilty ones; and that all who believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood, apart from works.
- VI. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into Heaven, and His present life there for us, as High Priest and Advocate.
- VII. We believe that our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ will personally return and set up His kingdom wherein He will rule and reign in righteousness.
- VIII. We believe that all who trust by faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born again of the Holy Spirit, and thereby become children of God.
- IX. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the blessedness of the saved, and the retribution of the lost.
